

CERTIFIED DRIVER INTERVENTION PROGRAMS

Listed below are the 72-hour driver intervention programs currently offered in and around Franklin County which can be used to satisfy your probation condition. It is your responsibility to call and determine the price of the programs, where they are located, and the available dates. Most programs are held at local hotels and begin on Thursday evening and conclude on Sunday afternoon, but verify the details with each individual program. When registering, you are to report ALL PRIOR ALCOHOL RELATED OFFENSES, INCLUDING OVIs WHICH WERE AMENDED AS PART OF A PLEA BARGAIN.

It is your responsibility to sign a Release of Information form with the agency of your choice so that your probation officer can be notified of your participation and any aftercare or further assessment recommendations. Franklin County Probation Fax #: 614-645-8626.

It is also required that the program you attend relay proof of your attendance to the Franklin County Municipal Clerk of Courts. Clerk's Fax #: 614-645-6948. Failure to do so may result in a warrant being issued for your arrest.
